FIABCI Malaysia names Tan Sri Lim Kang Hoo "Property Man Of The Year"

KUALA LUMPUR: Prominent businessman Tan Sri Lim Kang Hoo has been named the "Property Man of the Year" by the International Real Estate Federation (Fiabci) at its 23rd Malaysia Property Awards here last night.

Sultan Ibrahim of Johor, who was the Guest-of-Honour at the gala dinner and awards ceremony, presented the prestigious award which is touted as the Oscars of the real estate industry.

The annual event was attended by the crème de la crème of the property industry and often serves as an inspiration for industry players to strive for better excellence.

Fiabci Malaysia in its citation said the award was in recognition of Lim's outstanding leadership in construction and property development in the country.

He was chosen from several nominees by an independent panel of eminent people appointed by Fiabci.

"I am humbled and honoured to receive this coveted award," said Lim. "This is also a wonderful acknowledgement by my peers in the property industry of my 40-year track record in this business," he added.

Lim, 60, is the Executive Vice-Chairman of Iskandar Waterfront Holdings Sdn Bhd – the master developer of prime waterfront land in Johor Bahru. He is also the co-founder and Executive Chairman of Ekovest Berhad, a multi-disciplinary construction-based Group, and sits on board of several other listed entities.

Last year, Lim was also conferred the "Lifetime Achievement Award" during the 6th World Chinese Economic Forum in Chongqing, China.
